

Malaysia - Employment Pass

STEP 8: ARRIVAL

Assignee enters Malaysia and coordinates with FGI for collection of the original passport for Employment Pass endorsement at the MYID.

- Estimated turnaround: Approximately 1 week

STEP 7: VISA APPLICATION

Assignee applies for Single Entry Visa (SEV) at the Malaysian Consulate General in the Country of Residence.

- Estimated turnaround: Varies by consulate

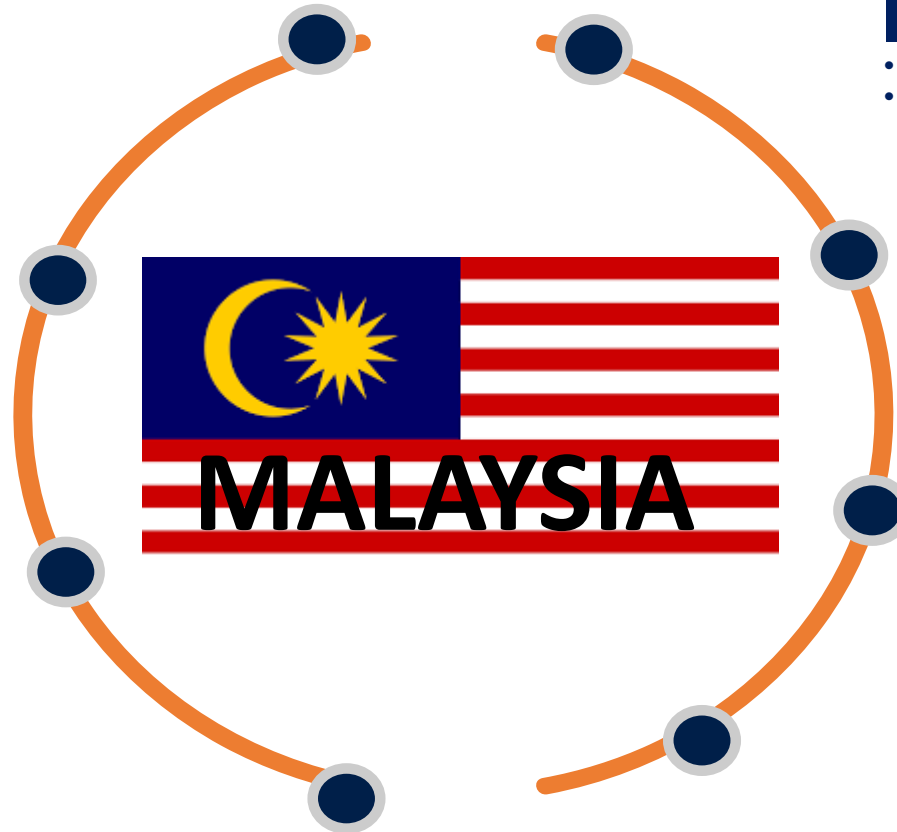
STEP 6: VWR LETTER

VWR letter is couriered to the assignee in the country of his/her residence.

STEP 5: VISA ISSUANCE

MYID issues the Visa with Reference (VWR) letter.

- Estimated Turnaround: Approximately 1 week



STEP 1: INITIATION

- Client initiates the case with FGI.
- Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.

STEP 2: DOCUMENTATION

FGI reviews the documents for accuracy of the information and informs client of any missing documentation.

STEP 3: APPLICATION SUBMISSION

FGI receives the complete set of documents, the Stage 1 and Stage 2 applications are sent to the Malaysian Immigration Department (MYID).

STEP 4: APPLICATION STAGE 1 AND 2

Application of Stage 1 and Stage 2 to the MYID is completed by our partner in Malaysia.

- Estimated turnaround: Approximately 2-3 weeks
