

## VISITOR VISA WITH NO REMUNERATED ACTIVITIES (SHORT TERM) PROCESS MAP

### STEP 2: VISA APPOINTMENT

Depending on the Mexican consulate of application, an appointment may be necessary. Note that entry visas are not required at all for applicants who hold a valid visa for Canada, Japan, the UK, the US or a Schengen member state; or permanent residency in Chile, Colombia or Peru.

### STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI.FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI. Estimated Turnaround: 1- 3 days.

### STEP 3: CONSULAR VISA APPLICATION

The applicant plus any accompanying family members should apply for entry visas at the Mexican consulate in the country of residence. Personal appearance is typically required.

Processing time: 1 week

### STEP 4: VISA COLLECTION

The applicant plus any accompanying family members should apply for entry visas at the Mexican consulate in the country of residence. Personal appearance is typically required.

### STEP 5: ENTRY TO MEXICO

The applicant may now enter Mexico and may begin work after this step.
